Education Requirements for School-Age Child Care Assistants

Must attach a copy of a transcript from an accredited institution.

Twelve (12) credits in early childhood education or child development, elementary education, recreation, group social work or a related field or a four (4) year degree in elementary education. Experience Requirement: At least 540 hours of documented supervised experience over a nine (9) month span of time working with children ages 5-12.

OR a four (4) year degree in early elementary education, recreation, group social work or a related field. Experience Requirement: At least 270 hours of documented supervised experience.

Other Requirements School-Age Child Care Assistants

School-Age Child Care Assistants should be flexible, demonstrate an ability to lead organized activities, including homework assistance, art, sports and games, cultural arts and theme activities. He/she must have an understanding of child development and school-age care, and have previous experience working with youth and in leading activities.

School-Age Child Care Assistants must be at least twenty-one (21) years of age and possess current American Red Cross, CPR and first aid certifications, and Medication Administration Certification. In addition, all Child Care Assistants must be fingerprinted, pass a criminal background check, and provide a completed medical history form and proof of a negative tuberculin test prior to the date of employment.

Salary Range: Based on education and experience—\$10.00 to \$15.00 per hour. Applicants must be available for two-day training on August 30th & 31st (3:00-6:00 PM). Positions begin on September 6th; School-year and six-week summer program.
