Launched in 2003, this program introduces children in grades K-8 to projects including electronics and STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) activities.

Teaches students advanced uses of audio visual and design technology. A portable lab makes it possible for all students to participate.

#### KidZ Sports

Children are given the opportunity to play sports in a team environment after school. Students not enrolled in ERfC After School-Age Care Centers can also participate.
